WAIVER FROM ITEM PRICING

CONSUMER RIGHTS UNDER ERIE COUNTY LAW #7 1997

This Establishment agrees to:

1. Maintain a customer Price Check Scanner in a conspicuous area.
This location must have an appropriate sign posted.
2. Not charge a customer a price for any item which exceeds the item price, shelf price, sales price, or advertised price.
3. Make a special payment to consumers who have been overcharged.

Procedures for Receiving Special Payment for Overcharge:

1. Consumer must notify store of overcharge in person or writing. This notice must include evidence of loss (i.e. receipt).
2. Upon verification the establishment must tender:
 - a. the difference in price plus an amount equal to 10 times the difference, but not less than one dollar or more than 10 dollars;
 - b. if more than one identical stock keeping unit is purchased, the consumer will receive the payment in 2(a), plus the difference in price on the additional items.
3. The consumer must complete a Weights & Measures Price Discrepancy Report provided by the Establishment.
4. Consumers should contact the Erie County Bureau of Weights and Measures (825-1310) if any of their rights described above have been violated. Retain all records of the transaction, sales, ads, receipts, etc.
