

COVID-19 Data Update

Week ending March 5, 2022

All data are provisional.

447 new COVID-19 cases were recorded for the week ending March 12. This is a 22% decline compared to the previous week (574 cases) – the ninth consecutive week of decline.

The weekly COVID-19 positivity rate was 2.0%, down from 2.7% the previous week.

Overall COVID-19 diagnostic tests totaled 22,407, on par with 21,314 tests the previous week.

7-day case rate per 100,000 persons was 47, down from 60 the previous week – the ninth consecutive week of case rate decline.

Buffalo city COVID-19 cases comprised ~35% of new COVID-19 cases this past week (Buffalo city population is 29.2% of all Erie County residents).

The ZIP code 14221 had the highest number of reported COVID-19 cases, at 28 cases; zero ZIP codes in Erie County had a case rate higher than 100 per 100,000 persons over seven days.

Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (March 2020-present)



Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group (March 6-12, 2022)







