

COVID-19 Data Update

Week ending May 14, 2022

All data are provisional.

4,738 new COVID-19 cases were recorded for the week ending May 14, 2022. This is a 5% decrease compared to the previous week's total (5,005 cases). These data do not include at-home tests. This is the first weekly case total decline since the week ending 3/12/2022. The weekly COVID-19 positivity rate was 20.2%, similar to the previous week's COVID-19 positivity rate of 20.1%.

Overall COVID-19 diagnostic tests totaled 23,414, down from the previous week's total of 24,951 tests.

7-day case rate per 100,000 persons was , up from 525 for the previous week.

Buffalo city COVID-19 cases comprised ~32% of new COVID-19 cases this past week. (Buffalo city population is 29.2% of all Erie County residents).

28 ZIP codes had a 7-day case rate over 500 per 100,000 persons. The ZIP code 14221 had the highest number of reported COVID-19 cases, at 298 reported cases.

Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (March 2020-present)



Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group (May 8-14, 2022)







