

COVID-19 Data Update

Week ending June 25, 2022

All data are provisional.

831 new COVID-19 cases were recorded for the week ending June 25, 2022. This is a 18% increase compared to the previous week's total (702 cases). These data do not include at-home tests. This is the first weekly case total increase since early May 2022. The weekly COVID-19 positivity rate was 7.6%, an increase from the previous week's COVID-19 positivity rate of 6.4%.

Overall COVID-19 diagnostic tests totaled 10,985, down from the previous week's total of 11,046 tests.

7-day case rate per 100,000 persons was 87, up from 74 for the previous week.

Buffalo city COVID-19 cases comprised ~29% of new COVID-19 cases this past week. (Buffalo city population is 29.2% of all Erie County residents).

All ZIP codes had a 7-day case rate under 200 per 100,000 persons, with the exception of 14203, whose 24 cases and small population led to a very high weekly case rate.

Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (March 2020-present)



Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group (June 19-25, 2022)





The week ending June 18 was the last week of reporting for the 2021-2022 school year.



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
