

## **COVID-19 Data Update**

### Week ending October 29, 2022

All data are provisional.

1,304 new COVID-19 cases were recorded for the week ending October 29, 2022. This is nearly the same as the previous week's total of 1,311 cases. These data do not include at-home tests. The weekly COVID-19 positivity rate increased slightly from 12.1% to 12.5%. 10,418 overall reported COVID-19 diagnostic tests were nearly the same as the previous week's total of 10,800 tests.

7-day case rate per 100,000 persons was 136.7, also nearly the same as the previous week's rate of 137.4. Erie County remains in a "medium" COVID-19 Community Level per CDC indicators. And, Erie County remains in "high" transmission per CDC community transmission metrics.

Buffalo city COVID-19 cases comprised 29.3% of new COVID-19 cases this past week. (Buffalo city population is 29.2% of all Erie County residents).

Erie County COVID-19 Wastewater Surveillance Data: graphic unavailable for this reporting period. The most recent COVID-19 wastewater surveillance data through October 25, 2022 showed SARS-CoV-2 viral particles in the top 60-79% of samples collected since 12/1/21 within the Bird Island and Lackawanna sewersheds. Big Sister Creek, City of Tonawanda and Southtowns were in the 40-59% category; Amherst and Kenmore-Tonawanda were in the 20-39% category.

Also through October 25, 2022, over the past two weeks the Amherst, Big Sister Creek and Bird Island sewersheds showed a 99-10% decrease; the City of Tonawanda and Kenmore-Tonawanda showed a 9-0% decrease; Lackawanna and Southtowns showed a 10-99% increase. Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (March 2020-present)



Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group (October 23-29, 2022)






