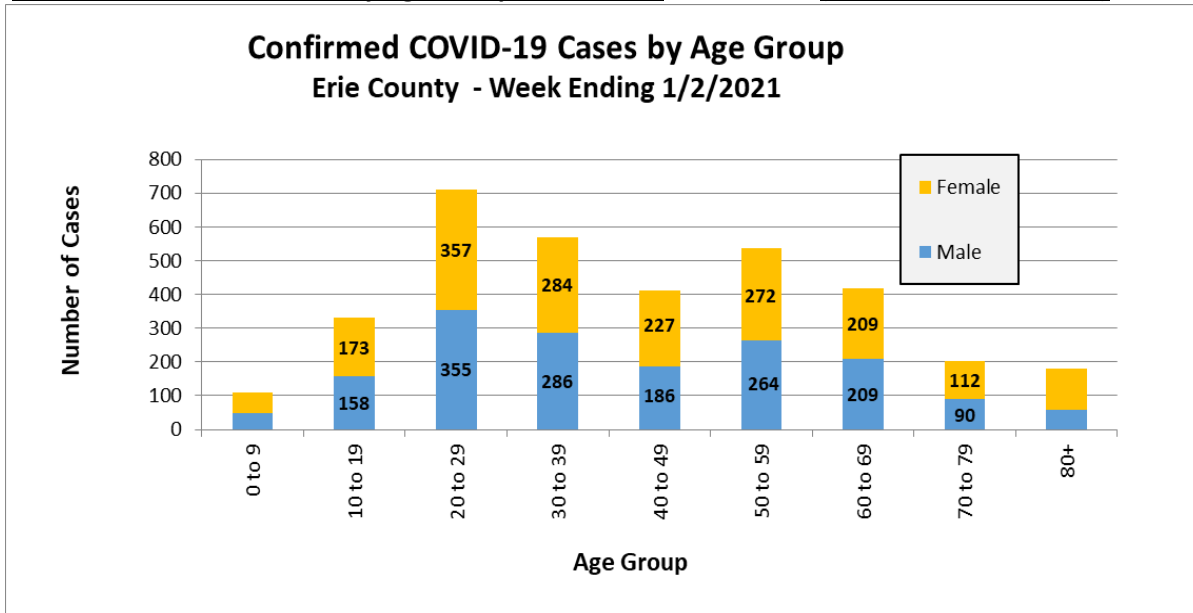
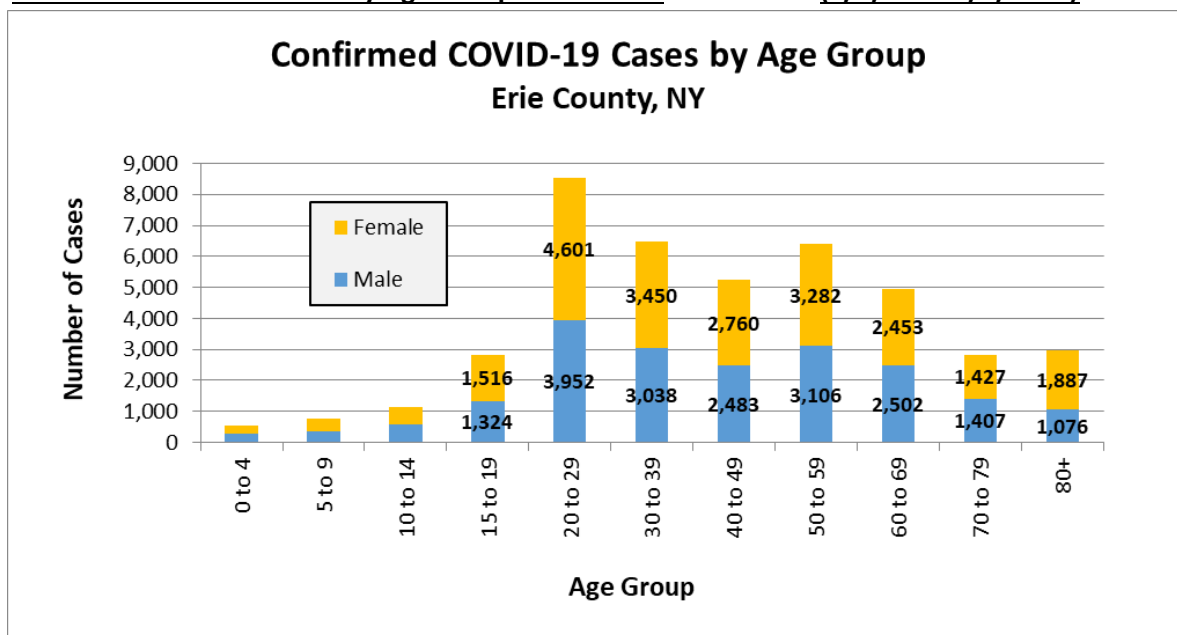


Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (12/27/2020-1/2/2021)
