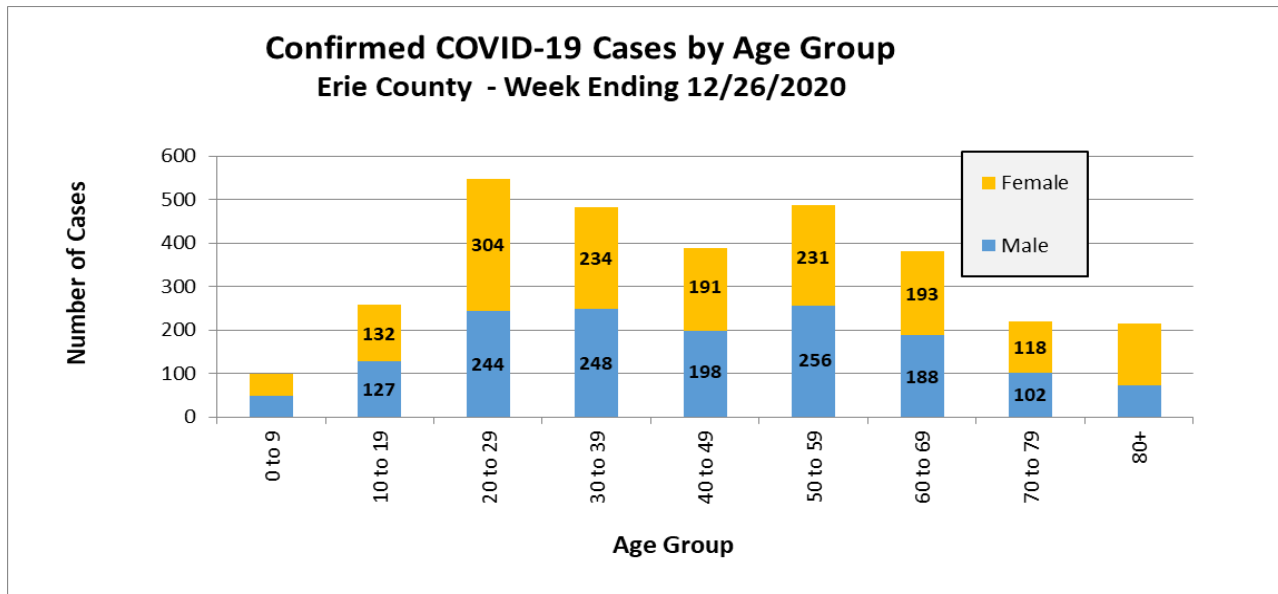
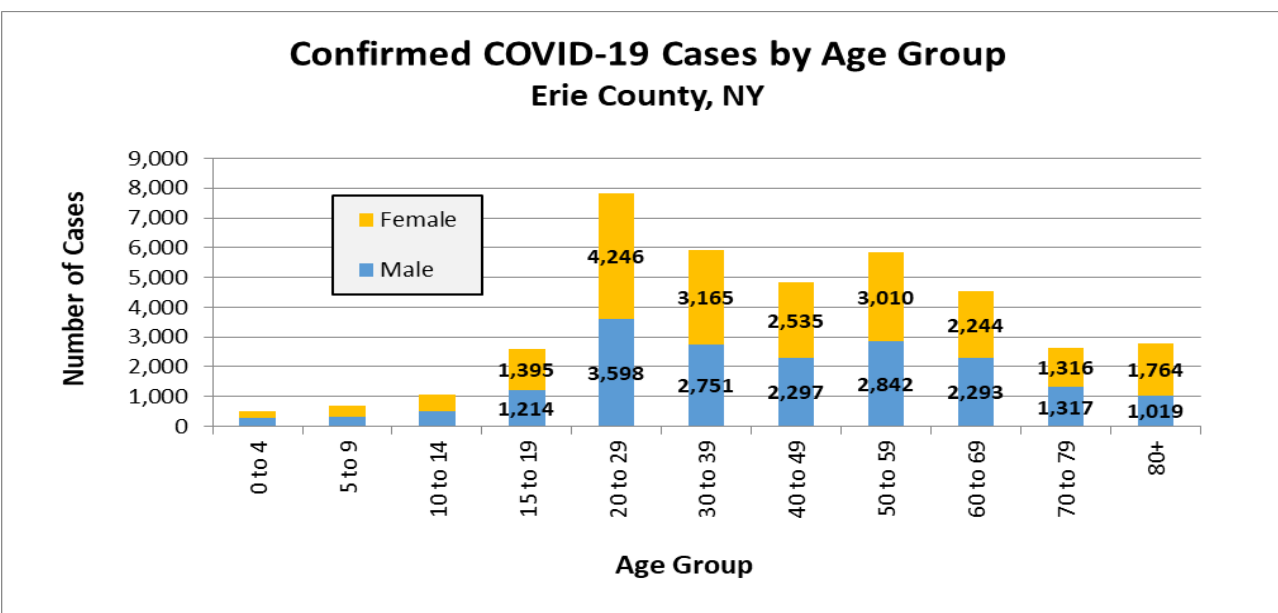


Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (12/20/2020-12/26/2020)
