

COVID-19 Data Update

Through March 2023

The Erie County Department of Health (ECDOH) moved to a monthly reporting schedule for COVID-19 data. Summaries of confirmed cases and trends, confirmed cases by residence, hospitalizations and mortality data are included in this report. Previous weekly reports are available on the ECDOH web site (www.erie.gov/health). State and federal COVID-19 data sources are listed on the last page of this report.

- ECDOH confirmed **3,080 COVID-19 cases** in March 2023, a 41% decrease from 5,212 cases in February 2023. These data do not include at-home tests.
- Wastewater surveillance data has shown decreasing trends in detected COVID-19 viral particles across all collection areas in the past months. See map and trends at www.erie.gov/covid19-wastewater (dashboard).
- Based on CDC measures for COVID-19 Community Level, Erie County has been changed to "low."
- Weekly COVID-19 positivity rates from reported test results in March 2023 ranged from 8-15%.



COVID-19 Cases by Age Group and Gender (March 2020-March 2023)


