Score	Descriptor	Additional Guidance on Strengths/Weaknesses
10	Model	Exceptionally strong (the standard to meet for field or discipline with essentially no weaknesses)
9	Exceptional	Extremely strong with negligible weaknesses
8	Outstanding	Very strong with some minor weaknesses
7	Excellent	Strong with numerous minor weaknesses
6	Very Good	Strong but with at least one moderate weakness
5	Good	Strong but at least one major weakness
4	Satisfactory	Some strengths but with some moderate weaknesses
3	Fair	Some strengths but with at least one major weakness
2	Marginal	A few strengths and a few major weaknesses
1	Poor	Very few strengths and numerous major weaknesses
Minor Weakness: An easily addressable weakness that does not substantially lessen impact.
