

ERIE COUNTY TAX LIEN FORECLOSURE HAS BEEN COMMENCED

HOMEOWNER WARNING NOTICE UNDER REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW §1144

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTICE CAREFULLY

As of September 2, 2025, there are unpaid Erie County property taxes due in connection to property identified on the List of Delinquent Taxes which was filed in the Erie County Clerk's Office on the 9th day of September, 2025.

The unpaid 2022 and prior (if applicable) Erie County taxes are being foreclosed.

To obtain the total amount due in unpaid Erie County taxes and the total needed to pay off the taxes subject to foreclosure, please contact the Erie County's Office of Real Property Tax Services directly at 716-858-8333 or by emailing ec-rpts@erie.gov.

Under New York State law, we are required to send you this notice to inform you that you are at risk of losing your home.

Attached to this notice is a list of government approved housing counseling agencies which provide free counseling. You can also call the New York State Office of the Attorney General's Homeowner Protection Program (HOPP) toll-free consumer hotline to be connected to free housing counseling or legal services at 1-855-HOME-456 (1-855-466-3456), or visit their website at <https://homeownerhelpny.org/>. Housing counselors from New York-based agencies listed on the website above are trained to help homeowners who are having problems making their tax payments and can help you find the best option for your situation.

Please leave a detailed message that includes the subject property address and a representative of Lippes Mathias, LLP, will return your call as soon as possible.

While we cannot assure that a mutually agreeable resolution is possible, we encourage you to take immediate steps to try to achieve a resolution.

The longer you wait, the fewer options you may have.

You may be barred from entering into a payment plan or from being permitted to make any payment to save your home after the "Redemption Date". **In your case, the "Redemption Date" is November 10, 2025.**

IMPORTANT: You have the right to remain in your home until you receive a court order telling you to leave the property; however, you may lose the right to continue ownership of your home after the Redemption Date. Although a foreclosure has been commenced, you still have the right to remain in the home until a court orders you to leave.

This notice is not an eviction notice, however a foreclosure has been commenced against you that may ultimately result in eviction.

You should also be aware that if you are a senior citizen, a person with a physical disability and/or a veteran, you may be entitled to a partial exemption from property taxes. If you are not already receiving one or more of these exemptions and would like information about the eligibility and application requirements, please contact your local assessor's office.
