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**DID YOU KNOW...**

- **LEAD** is a poison that can be found in paint, dust & soil.
- **LEAD** poisoning can cause serious health problems in children & adults.
- **LEAD** paint is most likely present in homes & properties built before 1978.
- This class teaches you how to **USE** lead safe work practices



The EPA requires contractors, property managers, and landlords to use lead safe work practices
