## INSTRUCTIONS

1. This application must be accompanied by one set of specifications.
2. The report must include the companion Form Gen. 134R in triplicate.
3. This application must also be accompanied by plans in triplicate one of which will be returned to the applicant. The set intended for filing with the Department of Health must be of sufficient clarity and legibility to permit satisfactory microfilming.
  - 3a. White prints are preferred but if blue prints are submitted, an area at least 4 in. by 7 in. must be blanked out to permit affixing the approval stamp on the face of the plans.
4. The project should be discussed with the local public health engineer and all plans and papers must be submitted to him.
5. The project must comply with the provisions of the Sanitary Code. Bulletin 31 entitled "Policies Governing the Preparation of Plans for Artificial Swimming Pools" shall serve as a guide in the development of the project.

The plans will be returned to the individual signing the application unless otherwise specified below.
