- **LEAD** is a poison that can be found in paint, dust & soil.
- **LEAD** poisoning can cause serious health problems in children & adults.
- **LEAD** paint is most likely present in homes & properties built before 1978.

This class teaches you how to **USE** lead safe work practices and **RECOGNIZE** unsafe practices

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Anyone who intends to have work done by a contractor.
- Anyone living in a rental unit maintained by a landlord or property manager
- Anyone working on their own home *
