## Building and Performance Intern

Work will be focused on energy use in county buildings and identifying efficiency improvement strategies

### Scope of Work:

- **Building Electric Survey** – In preparation for any Clean Heating/Cooling, EV Infrastructure or Solar installations we would want to know the condition and capacity of the electric service at all of the buildings throughout the County.
- **Benchmarking updates** – continued support for updating energy consumption in buildings, track energy trends and identify outliers, correlate savings to specific energy projects including EPC
- **Position start date to be determined.**

## Green Fleet Intern

Work will be focused on the county's vehicle fleet and transitioning to EV to lower overall emissions

### Scope of Work:

- **EV Transition plan** – Work with fleet manager identify needs of each vehicle and potential electric replacements, research heavy equipment options and timelines for replacement, develop re-imbursement policy for charging at non-county locations
- **EV Infrastructure plan** – Help identify the needs of each facility, appropriate size and quantity of charging equipment, cost and schedule for development, grant funding availability and requirements, emergency recharging plan and equipment
