## Population & Age

## Cost-Burdened by Housing

Based on 2017-2021 American Community Survey Data, US Census Bureau.

HUD defines **housing cost-burdened** residents as those "who pay more than **30 percent** of their income for housing" and "may have difficulty affording necessities such as food, clothing, transportation, and medical care."

**48.0%** of renters spend over 30% of their income on housing.

**25.4%** of home owners spend over 30% of their income on housing.

**29.7%** of all households spend over 30% of their income on housing.
