

BUFFALO AND ERIE COUNTY GREENWAY FUND

Temporary Placement of Funding Acknowledgment Signage

This document is intended to assist Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund grant recipients in the temporary placement of funding acknowledgment signs at their project sites.

The sign should be installed: a. in a prominent location that is readily and easily visible to a majority of site visitors or passersby, b. in a safe, secure position that avoids creating visual or physical traffic obstacles for drivers and pedestrians, and c. for the period of construction and six (6) months after the completion of the project.

Installation Specifications

The metal sign may be installed on posts or on a sturdy construction barrier, such as a fence:

1. Posts:

- Use 4"x 4" pressure treated wood, primed and painted white.
- Attach posts to the rear of the sign panel with surface fasteners through the sign face. Openings for the fasteners should be made from the face of the sign toward the back to reduce damage to the sign. Holes should be 7/16".
- Place posts in compacted soil to a minimum depth of 2' - 6".
- Install sign plumb and perpendicular to approaching pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

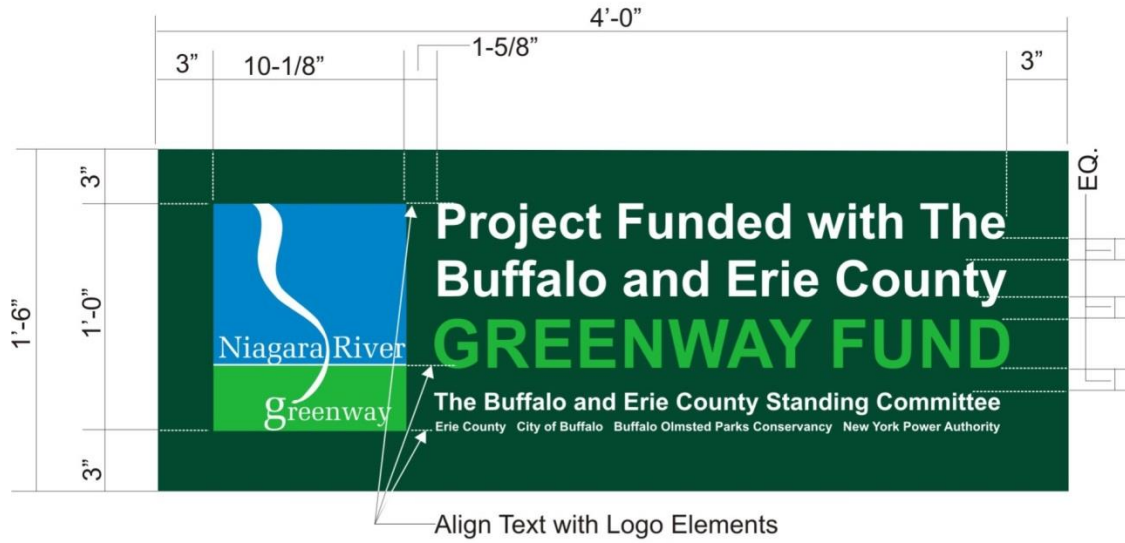
2. Hanging:

- Openings for the fasteners should be made from the face of the sign toward the back to reduce damage to the sign. Holes should be 7/16"
- Use secure, durable theft-proof hardware to attach the sign to the construction barrier. Attach the sign at all four corners to prevent it from falling, flapping in the wind, or appearing crooked.
- Hang sign plumb and perpendicular to approaching pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

Sign Pick Up and Drop Off

Funding acknowledgment signs are the property of the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund.
