Local governments play a key role in improving roadway safety for people of all ages and abilities. This workshop, facilitated by national walkability expert Dan Burden and traffic safety engineer Gina Wilkolaski, PE, introduces the Safe Systems approach along with practical strategies to enhance safety across multimodal networks. Participants will explore how roadway design, traffic operations, and coordination shape safety outcomes, along with core principles to reduce crashes and conflicts. The session outlines how to move projects from concept to implementation, including coordination, jurisdiction, funding, and delivery considerations. By the end, participants will understand how design, policy, and collaboration support safer, more accessible transportation systems.
