OVERVIEW

Chief Jess Strom - BNIA Fire Department & Captain Aimee Kinsley - BFD Training Bureau with an all-female fire instructor staff will host 2 classes for Erie County Women Firefighters Only! This class will run Sunday September 18th 2022 from 8:00AM to 4:00PM. Designed to build confidence and character through hands-on fire training. 8 Stations will include hose line advancement in smoke conditions, search and rescue, one and two firefighter forced entry, survival skills., ventilation. All participants must be interior qualified female firefighters and have completed Interior Firefighting Operations/Firefighter I or equivalent. Participants will receive a T-shirt and lunch will be provided. Bring full turnout gear, SCBA w/spare cylinder, and a hand tool. Come be empowered!

CONTENT

By the end of this training firefighters will show proficiency in various methods in advancing an attack line to a predetermined location and the basic reasoning for fire attack under smoke conditions. Show proficiency in primary and secondary search techniques including victim removal using various types of drags and carries. Force an inward and outward swinging door using both the one and two firefighter technique and demonstrate various survival skills while following a hose line in blacked out conditions.
