The county engineer is requiring Drager to weld reinforcement bars on the bottom of the building to distribute the weight more properly before we can use. -Lots of classes on the schedule, Fire Instructor I and II, Fire Officer I and II, 1403 classes, etc. Montour Falls will be reduced operations for remodeling for at least 2 years. -Old recruitment trailer (Forcible Entry) has been stripped and repainted, new rims, new tires, new brakes and was sent to the Sprinkler Fitters Union. The students are working on it and it will be the new Engine Company Ops trailer. It hopefully will be in service around the 1st of the year. -Discussion on lesson plans for all training provided by the county, training authorization letters, gear inspection and funding for supplies necessary for training.
