

**Course Name: Fire Mutual Aid Resource Management** 

Full Description: One of the prime responsibilities of the New York State Fire Mobilization and Mutual Aid Plan is to facilitate the efficient loan of resources and equipment between fire departments, counties and state agencies during disasters. This course explains the procedure that establishes the minimum recommended requirements to track resources sent from one county or region to another. This is also to establish a uniform method of tracking resources deployed during the State Fire Mobilization Plan to ensure resources are not lost through a statewide standard accountability system. This plan is utilized when the Fire Mobilization plan has been activated and can also be adopted by any county or agency to fit their needs. The Office of Fire Prevention and Control will use this to comply with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as it follows the ICS resource tracking guidelines. This course is beneficial to officers, chiefs, disaster coordinators, radio coordinators, dispatchers and others who may be involved in receiving or providing out-of-county deployments of fire resources.
