

Fire and Life Safety Educator

Full Description: This engaging course is designed for professionals who will coordinate and deliver fire and/or life safety education to the public. It is based on NFPA 1035: Standard on Fire and Life Safety Educator, Public Information Officer, Youth Firesetter Intervention Specialist, and Youth Firesetter Program Manager Professional Qualifications. Students will explore topics such as community risk reduction, historical fire case studies, human behavior during emergencies, basic fire behavior and protection, injury prevention, presentation strategies, age group characteristics, community resources and partnerships, selecting appropriate course materials, working with the media, course administration, and evaluation methods.
