THIS PRESENTATION PROVIDES AN IN-DEPTH EXAMINATION OF PRE-HOSPITAL MEDICAL OPERATIONS WITHIN AUSTERE AND TACTICAL ENVIRONMENTS. IT WILL HIGHLIGHT THE MISSION-SPECIFIC PLANNING, EQUIPMENT LOADOUTS, AND OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS REQUIRED TO SUPPORT EFFECTIVE MEDICAL RESPONSE IN NON-TRADITIONAL AND HIGH-RISK SETTINGS.

ADDITIONALLY, THE PRESENTATION WILL CLEARLY DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN RESCUE TASK FORCE (RTF) MODELS, TACTICAL EMERGENCY CASUALTY CARE (TECC) PRINCIPLES, DEDICATED TACTICAL MEDICAL TEAMS, AND ACTIVE ASSAILANT RESPONSE FRAMEWORKS, OUTLINING THE UNIQUE ROLES, CAPABILITIES, AND APPLICATIONS OF EACH.
