Full Description: Basic Passenger Vehicle Rescue (BPVR) provides education and training in passenger vehicle rescue. The program covers the awareness and operational-level requirements of NFPA 1006, Chapter 8, Common Passenger Vehicle Rescue. Educational topics include: scene safety, vehicle design, construction and terminology, tools and equipment, incident action plan application, and scene management. Skills training involves vehicle stabilization, victim access, care, and disentanglement techniques.
