## Fire Prevention and Control

**Course Name:** Hazmat Tech Mod 2 – Interpreting the Hazardous Environment

**Full Description:** This second in a series of Hazardous Materials Technician modules provides emergency response personnel with skills to interpret and better understand the hazardous environments they will be working in. This course covers portions of OSHA 1910.120 and NFPA 472. Topics include the use of chemistry for the emergency responder; monitoring, detection and identification instrumentation; proper sampling protocols and identification of special response incidents such as Clandestine Laboratories and Weapons of Mass Destruction/ Terrorism incidents.
