Course Name: Fire Officer 1

Full Description: Fire Officer I (NFPA 1021-2014 ed.) Note: Fire Officer I is offered in two course formats. This format is the standard offering and all Fire Officer I content is delivered in one course. Students can also complete the requirements of Fire Officer I by completing the five separate Fire Officer I Modules as outreach courses in any order: Leadership and Supervision, Company Training & Community Risk Reduction, Firefighter Health and Safety, Planning and Emergency Response, and Fireground Strategy and Tactics for First Arriving Companies and then applying for a Fire Officer I certificate. This is the first course in the Fire Officer series, addressing all of the job performance requirements found in Chapter 4 of NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications. Topics include assuming the role of company officer, fire department organization, leadership, supervision, communications, building construction, pre-incident planning, and company level training. Additionally, the Fireground Strategy & Tactics for First Arriving Companies course is embedded within the Fire Officer I course and covers topics such as scene size-up, engine company operations, truck company operations, and response to non-fire emergencies.
