ATV/UTV NIGHT OPS TRAINING

Once again in 2026, the Erie County Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services will host a UTV/ATV Night Ops Safety Training for any Public Safety Agency that would like to train members in the safe operation of a company-owned UTV or ATV during night hours. ESU Staff provides this training as part of the ROHVA Safety Program.

There will be 9 nights of training on the following dates, starting at 2030 hrs., at EC Forestry, **11200 Genesee Road, East Concord, NY.**

July 13th / 14th / 15th / 16th / 20th / 22nd / 23rd and 24th

Agencies should bring their department-owned ATV or UTV, and no more than 2 or 4 members (respectively) for each class. All participating students must have proper PPE (department-issued helmet, eye protection, gloves, long-sleeve shirt, and sturdy boots) to participate. This will be rain or shine, so please dress appropriately. There will be a limit of 6 units per night of training. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis. All personnel driving the ATV/UTV **MUST** have completed an ATV or UTV Operations Course (verified prior to the training). Departments are highly encouraged to bring their thermal imaging cameras for this training.

There is no charge for this training.
