Description: Includes duties and responsibilities of the engine company: it builds on the fire behavior knowledge presented to students in BEFO & IFO/SCBA courses, fire extinguishment using hose/nozzle systems, standpipes, and master streams. It thoroughly examines different types of hose and nozzles and hydraulically evaluates flows from different hose/nozzle systems to ensure the proper flow is achieved. It concludes with live fire evolutions focusing on operations as an engine company.
