Course Name: Basic Wildland Fire Suppression

Full Description:

Developed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Forest Rangers for NYS structural firefighters involved in wildland fire suppression. The course contents include jurisdiction and responsibilities, fire behavior, wildland fire elements and size-up, basic use of tools and equipment, general concepts related to fire suppression, securing 19 REV 7/28/26 the control line, and standards for safety. There is a classroom session followed by an outdoor skills session. All students must be properly clothed and be capable of using digging or chopping tools for fire line construction with direction from a Forest Ranger.
