		for the New York Food for New York Families Round 2 Competitive Grant RFP that outlines the FPC 2024 Goals that directly relate to the program goals detailed in the RFP. If awarded, this grant would also fund an FPC Coordinator position. If both the Fellowship and the grant are awarded, potential options could include bringing on another person to help with the grant or the FPC administrative tasks. In addition, the grant would be used to fund a program, Farm to Families, that would purchase produce boxes from FreshFix to be delivered to 400 families/week for 52 weeks by distributing the boxes at childcare facilities in no income, low income, and ALICE (asset limited, income constrained, employed) communities. Grant recipients will
		be notified in May 2024.
