FARMERS MARKET SALSA RECIPE

INGREDIENTS



- 1/2 cup corn (fresh cooked or frozen)
- 1 can black beans, low-sodium (15 ounce, drained and rinsed)
- 1 cup tomatoes (fresh diced)
- 1/2 cup onion (yellow or red) (diced)
- 1/2 cup green pepper (diced)
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- 2 garlic <u>clove</u> (finely chopped)
- 1/2 cup picante sauce

DIRECTIONS

- · Wash hands with soap and water.
- Combine all ingredients in a large bowl. Chill until serving time.
- Drain before serving.
- Serve with low-fat baked tortilla chips or fresh vegetables.




It is high summer and our farmers are working hard. Visit a farmer this week for in-season fruits and vegetables.




