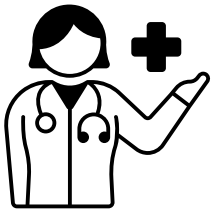

KNOW YOUR MEASLES IMMUNITY STATUS

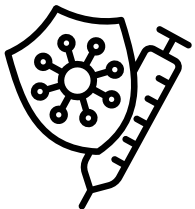
What's happening?

Measles outbreaks are occurring throughout the U.S. and Canada. Measles is a highly contagious, very serious disease. Unvaccinated people, including infants under 12 months old, are at high risk of severe illness - pneumonia - and death.



Call your doctor.

Ask if your medical records show proof of measles protection.



Unsure of your status? Get boosted.

Some doctor's offices and and most pharmacies offer MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccine. MMR vaccine is very safe and highly effective.
