StreetSmart Erie is a year-round public health and safety campaign focused on **reducing injuries and deaths on roads**, sidewalks and parking lots across the county.

THE NEED FOR ACTION

- From 2020 to 2023, Erie County experienced 210 fatal motor vehicle crashes and 46 pedestrian deaths
- In the first half of 2025 alone, there were **118 crashes** involving pedestrians, cyclists or skaters.



HOW WE'RE SPREADING THE MESSAGE

- Social media campaigns for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians.
- Upcoming topics: motorcyclists, transit users, e-bikes and scooters, and construction safety.
- Seasonal focuses: back to school, holiday driving, and winter road conditions.
