




Overdose Deaths, 2012-2025*






Overdose Death Demographics







Substances Detected by CPS Forensic Lab

- Substance samples seized by law enforcement
 - and analyzed by Erie County Central Police
 - Services Forensic Laboratory
- o 72 samples analyzed in 2025
 - 6 medetomidine detections
 - 12 BTMPS detections
 - 8 xylazine detections

New York State: 37% Decrease








Non-Fatal Overdose Reports 2022 - Present








Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) Dashboard Metrics



Dashboard Description

- Run by NYSDOH
- 14 metrics related to opioid and benzodiazepine prescriptions
 - Compares to other counties in NYS
 - Tracks improvement over time
- ECDOH working with NYSDOH to obtain more detailed data





Percentage of cohort patients receiving continuous buprenorphine for treatment of opioid use disorder for 6 months or more



Percentage of episodes when an opioid-naive patient received more than a seven-day supply from the initial opioid prescription



Metrics of Interest

- Prescriptions of buprenorphine for 6 months or more
 - Indicates people are sticking with MAT

- Opioid-naïve patients prescribed more than 7-day supply
 - Indicates potential overprescribing



Heat Map Updates

Data based on police reports complied by High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Office (HIDTA) and tabulated by Office of Harm Reduction (OHR)




Data Source

- Law enforcement reports and emergency service calls
 - Both fatal and non-fatal reports
 - 75% non-fatal
- Aggregated by HIDTA, sent daily to ECDOH
 - HIDTA determines which calls are OD events
- Heat maps are based on reports from a specific location and time period
 - City of Buffalo, 8-week periods




Helpful Analogy

- Overdose reports = pebbles dropped in water
- We can show where ripples overlap
- More ripples overlap = "hotter" cluster






8-Week Comparison, City of Buffalo




City of Buffalo: North






City of Buffalo: East/South






City of Buffalo: West/Central
