additional dining options

Community meals: Erie County Senior Services provides hot, nutritious meals during the lunchtime hour. Meals are served Monday through Friday at several locations in Buffalo. You or your spouse must be 60 years of age or older to be eligible.



Home-delivered meals: If you or a loved one are over the age of 60, living with a disability or physically unable to prepare meals on your own, you may be eligible to receive this service. Meals are delivered during the lunchtime hour Monday through Friday.
