Last year we had **50 provider agencies** who participated, and we expect a similar attendance this June! Agencies are looking to fill a wide range of clinical, support, residential, peer, and administrative support roles among others. We will be sharing our Career Fair flyer over the coming weeks where you will be able to scan a QR Code with the camera on your phone that will take you to the full list of attending provider agencies with links to their career opportunities to view in advance. Many agencies will be offering onsite interviews so career seekers should be prepared with their resumes.

New beginnings await...bring your best and join us on June 7th!

 Since its inception in 2016, the Erie County Department of Mental Health (ECDMH) has acted as a co-chair to facilitate the Treatment Workgroup of the Erie County Opioid Epidemic Task Force.

Subsequently treatment providers in Erie County have made significant strides to improve and increase access to addiction treatment and support services; including but not limited to:

- Increased peer and family support services;
- Walk-in and same day appointments;
- Greatly expanded medication assistance for Opioid Use Disorder-with over 11,000 slots available for Buprenorphine;
- Significantly expanded access to Vivitrol and rapid induction of buprenorphine;
- Doubled the availability of Opioid Treatment Program slots (Methadone Maintenance); and
- Deployed mobile treatment units.

With the advocacy and support of County Executive Poloncarz and the Erie County Legislature, ECDMH funding for the 24/7 Addiction Hotline at Crisis Services continues.
