2024 Golf Pass Application Golf Course Rules and Regulations

By purchasing a yearly golf pass from the Erie County Dept. of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry, you are agreeing to abide by the following rules and regulations of our golf course, as well as the park ordinances and laws. Repeat violation of these rules could result in revocation of your pass. This form will be required annually and will be kept on file.

Golf Course Policies

- All golfers must have a tee time. Walk-ins are welcome on the day of play if tee times are available.
- Any golfer found playing without a tee time will be asked to leave immediately.
- Golfers may check in up to ½ hour prior to tee time. Golfers attempting to check in earlier than ½ hour will be asked to come back.
- Rude, disrespectful behavior toward staff and/or other golfers will not be tolerated.
- *Observe Golf Etiquette:* Repair all ball marks, rake bunkers, and replace divots. Shirts must be worn at all times. Carts must remain at least 30 feet away from greens and bunkers.
- Golf carts are not allowed in the parking lot.
