The Erie County Parks department was founded in 1924 by the original Park Commissioners. Chestnut Ridge Park was the second park to be added to our system and was named after the large American Chestnut trees that once grew on the sled hill where the park casino now sits.

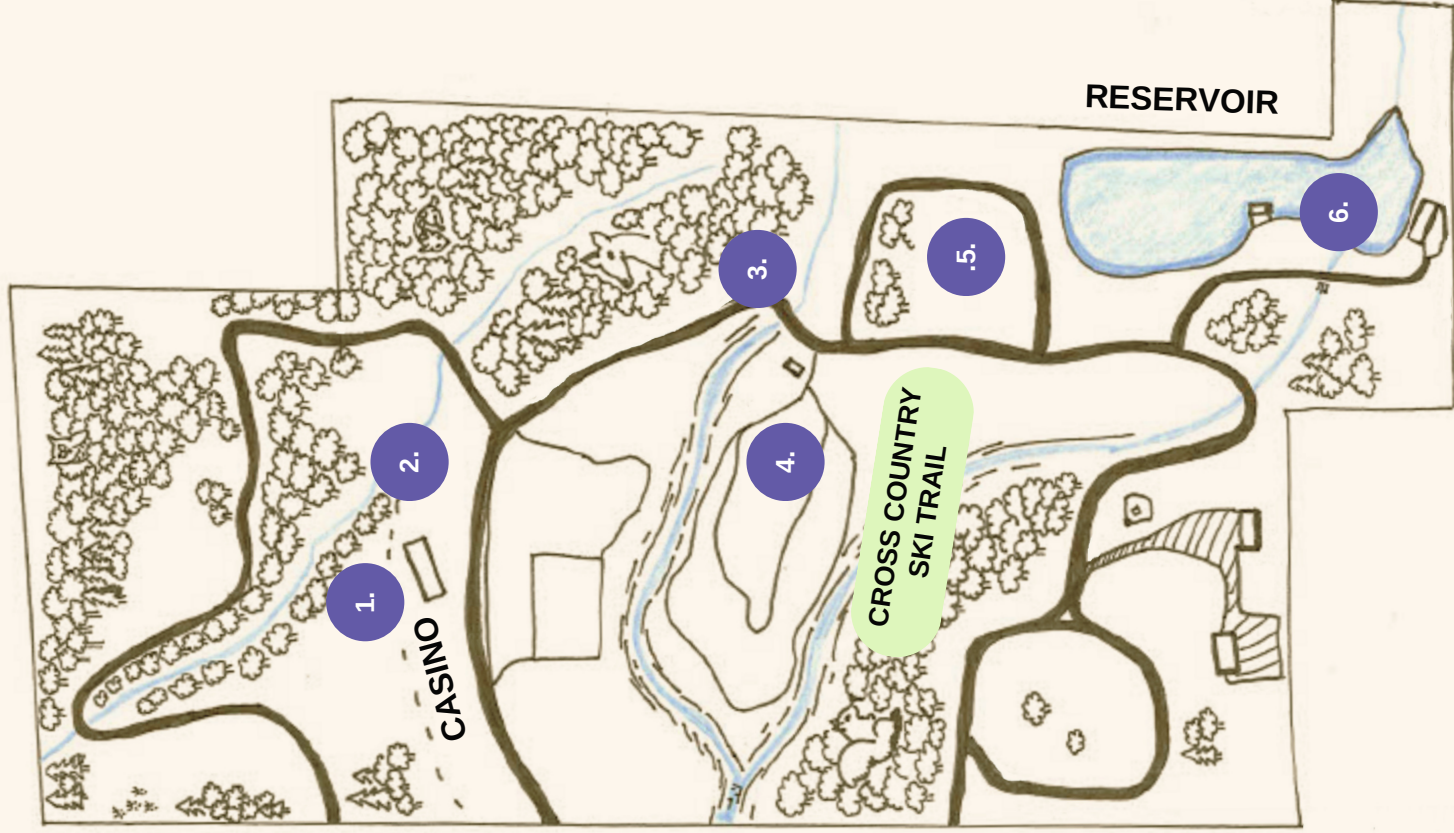
