## ***Golf Course Dog Policy***

Erie County is piloting a program allowing dogs on Grover Cleveland Golf Course in 2026.

- Dogs are only allowed on the course when accompanied by a registered walking golfer.
- Golfers playing in a tournament/outing should not bring their dog.
- Dogs must be leashed and under control at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed on carts.
- Not all dogs belong on a golf course. If considering bringing your dog, please use your best judgement. Only dogs that are well-trained, non-aggressive, and quiet should come to the course so as to not distract other golfers.
- Dogs are to stay off greens and out of bunkers.
- Dogs must be properly licensed, vaccinated and wear a collar with ID.
- Dogs over six (6) months of age must be spayed or neutered.
- Owners are responsible for picking up and disposing of dog waste in designated containers.
- Dogs that display aggression toward people or other dogs must be removed from Park immediately.
- Owners are legally and financially responsible for any damage or injury caused by their dog.

Any violation of these rules may result in the golfer and dog being asked to leave; no refunds will be given.
