Wet & Dry Sprinkler Systems, Fire Pumps & FM 200 Systems Fike System**

Contract is to be a two-year contract
for the period covering **January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2023**

I – General Information

Proposal to meet requirements for inspections and trip testing of wet and dry sprinkler systems and integrated equipment such as flow, pressure and tamper switch alarms per New York State Building Code (latest revision) guidelines for Water-Based Fire Protection Systems and once per year full flow testing of applicable fire pumps. All tests and inspections are to be conducted by a certified technician and documented with a full report indicating the results of each test and inspection and suggestions for any remedial work needed.

II – Locations and Equipment

The following locations are to be included in this contract coverage:

Erie County Correctional facility, Alden – Annual Fire Pump Full flow test only

134 West Eagle Street, Buffalo – (2) dry sprinkler systems

Erie County Holding Center, Buffalo – (1) wet sprinkler system & fire pump

Old & New County Hall, 92 Franklin & 25 Delaware, Buffalo – (2) dry, (1) wet sprinkler system and fire pump, & (1) FM 200 system

Erie County Mechanical Center, 11494 Walden, Alden – (1) wet sprinkler system

Rath Building, 95 Franklin St., Buffalo – (2) dry sprinkler systems, (1) Fike System, (2) ECARO-25 System

Youth Detention, 810 E. Ferry St., Buffalo – (1) wet sprinkler system (3) Fire Hydrant Tests

Erie County Family Court, 1 Niagara Plaza, Buffalo – (1) wet sprinkler system & fire pump

III – Frequency of service and scope of work:

Wet and dry sprinkler systems are to be inspected and tested per New York State Building Code guidelines (4) times per year, and trip tested (1) time per year. Submit a full report indicating all the zones tested. Verify operation of all alarms and indicate test results on report. Make recommendations for any remedial work needed.

Fire pumps are to be full flow tested (1) time per year. As part of the pump inspection and test: determine if pump is in service and in satisfactory working condition, thoroughly inspect components, control lines, mechanical condition, and adjust packing glands. Check for operation of relief valve and make adjustments as needed. Check and determine if pump is equipped with a properly sized suction and discharge line, check valve, bypass line and shut off valves. Check for properly equipped test header. Test jockey pump and fire pump for correct on-off pressures and adjust as needed. Activate pump from controller test connection to perform full flow test. Need to record voltage and full load amperage of pump. Compile and record pump data and submit a comprehensive report to include a graph showing pump efficiency. Restore jockey pump and fire pump to normal service after verification of proper operation.

FM 200 Systems/Fike are to be inspected (2) times per year in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines and recommendations of NFPA 2001.

Appointments are to be made prior to service with the chief engineer at each location so arrangements can be made for assisting personnel and security if applicable. Prints if available and system information are for review at each facility by contacting the chief engineer at each site. * **25 Delaware & 92 Franklin, Rath Building and Family Court to be tested on off hours.**

Payments for the above service are to be made in arrears of service in **quarterly installments**, upon receipt of invoice with supporting reports, signed work orders and/or job tickets indicating that the work has been performed.
