

Specification for On-Call Property Maintenance for Various County Facilities

Article I - General Information

Erie County Department of Public Works Division of Buildings and Grounds requires contractor to provide general property maintenance to include lawn mowing, shrub and tree pruning, garden bed maintenance, mulching of beds, and property clean-up on an as needed basis.

Contractor shall be able to perform various concrete flatwork for replacement of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, and driveway approach areas. All work shall meet ACI standards.

Contractor shall have all necessary equipment and personnel to properly perform work required. Any permits required by City of Buffalo, towns or villages shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

Article II - Scope of Work

2.1 Lawn Mowing and trimming services various properties on as needed basis. areas may have a height of 6 plus inches and to be cut to a height of 3 inches. The areas to be trimmed with trimmer each time it is mowed. Edging along curbs, walkways, and flower beds should not leave a gap of more than 1 inch.

Note: Contractor must be able and have equipment to mow steep grade areas.

Mowing and trimming may also require contractor to perform nuisance lawn mowing abatements at residential properties as specified by Erie County. This abatement includes mowing of grass and weeds that can exceed 8 inches in height. Requests will be on a per site authorization basis from Erie County.

2.2 Shrub and Tree Pruning

Various properties on as needed basis may require shrub and tree pruning. This service will require County representative direction and approval. Prune the shrub/tree to maintain the tree shape. Remove any branches from the lower third of the trunk and thin out the canopy if there are overcrowded branches. Trim dead and diseased branches first followed by inward-growing and rubbing branches. All debris to be removed from site. Contractor shall be able to provide stump grinding service.

2.3 Landscape Bed Maintenance

Various properties on as needed basis may require weeding and mulching.

All beds shall be weeded, cleaned of old mulch, debris, and tilled prior to mulching, depth shall have a minimum of 2 inches and not to exceed 4 inches and a weed preventative Pre-Emergent Herbicide (such as Preen) applied after application. All work requires prior County approval.

2.4 Concrete Flat Work

Properties on as needed basis may require concrete flat work for replacement of damaged sidewalks, walkways, driveways, and driveway approach areas. Contractor shall be able to complete work in a timely manner and provide all required barriers to protect finished area.

All concrete to be 4000 PSI, and reinforced with wire mesh over 3" compacted stone base. Walkways to be minimum of 4" approach areas to be minimum of 6".

Appropriate sealing compound to be sprayed after final finishing.

All concrete to have control joints at standard recommended locations.

All work shall meet or exceed ACI standards.

All debris must be removed from area and excavated area surrounding new work to be backfilled after forms are removed to avoid tripping hazard, and seeded if required.

Article III - Requirements

- 3.1 Contractor must have five years' experience in property maintenance landscaping service
- 3.2 Provide five references and contacts of prior or current projects at time of bid.
- 3.3 Contractor to document on each site including photographs providing address for each property prior to and after work completion. The contractor is to document the existing conditions of each site with respect to the grass weeds and vegetation
- 3.4 The contractor to complete all jobs within four days as scheduled - weather permitting dates and time work was performed rounded to the quarter hour in an itemized categorization of charges within 15 days of performing service. Additionally, the contractor must provide photographic documentation before and after services have been completed.
- 3.5 The contractor's invoices shall give a detailed description of each location (address). Any additional work required beyond the scope of this contract will require approval from Erie County DPW
- 3.6 Contractor must be able to perform work on some jobs consisting of extremely long grass and weeds and steep grades.
- 3.7 Contractor to provide point of contact phone numbers for service call and job site supervision.
- 3.8 Any subcontractors used must have the approval of Erie County Department of Public Works.
