The bidder accepts and agrees that language in substantially the following form will be included in the contract between the proposer and the County:

All deliverables created under this Agreement by the successful bidder are to be considered "works made for hire". If any of the deliverables do not qualify as "works made for hire", the successful bidder hereby assigns to the County all right, title and interest (including ownership of copyright) in such deliverables and such assignment allows the County to obtain in its name copyrights, registrations and similar protections which may be available. The successful bidder agrees to assist the County, if required, in perfecting these rights. The successful bidder shall provide the County with at least one copy of each deliverable.

The successful bidder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County for all damages, liabilities, losses and expenses arising out of any claim that a deliverable infringes upon an intellectual property right of a third party. If such a claim is made, or appears likely to be made, the successful bidder agrees to enable the County's continued use of the deliverable, or to modify or replace it. If the County determines that none of these alternatives is reasonably available, the deliverable will be returned.

All records compiled by the successful bidder in completing the work described in this Agreement, including but not limited to graphics, written reports, source codes, studies, drawings, blueprints, negatives of photographs, computer printouts, graphs, charts, plans, specifications and all other similar recorded data, shall become and remain the property of the County. The successful bidder may retain copies of such records for its own use.
